In celebration of Pro Bono Week and Veterans Day, The Veterans Consortium (TVC), the Neighborhood Legal Services Program (NLSP), and local corporate counsel legal departments are partnering with DC area law schools to host one-day pop-up clinics in three locations throughout the city to serve the needs of veterans—our nation's defenders.

- Volunteer attorneys will be working with volunteer law students to interview veterans and triage cases, offering an excellent opportunity to mentor future lawyers.
- Volunteers will receive training materials from TVC legal staff.
- Training will be in the form of online video-recorded modules. The training videos will be available for the attorneys to review on their own time prior to the clinic.
- TVC will advise the project.
